How to Install “AutoCad LT 97 for Windows”

- *Currently there are only 4 concurrent licenses available.*
- *You **MUST** use a FNAL NT account to install and run this product.*

Windows95 and WinNT4.x

1. Setting environment variables

Windows NT Users: (YOU MUST HAVE LOCAL ADMIN PRIVILEGE TO DO THIS!)

- a) In windows control panel, choose the System icon
- b) On the environment tab, under System Variables select the name of an existing variable.
- c) In the Variable box, clear the contents of the field. Then enter the name **ACADSERVER.**
- d) In the Value box clear the contents of the field. Then enter **ppdweb.fnal.gov** into the Value box.
- e) Choose Set.
- f) Choose OK

Windows 95 Users:

- a) Add the following line to the autoexec.bat file:
- b) Set ACADSERVER=ppdweb.fnal.gov
- c) Restart Windows 95

2. Click on Start and Choose RUN

3. In the open box, type: \\ppdserver1\pcapps\AutoCadLT97\setup.exe

Once all the steps are followed, you are ready to run AutoCAD LT 97
